BITS Pilani is a Deemed to be University, offering on-campus programs to more than 18,500 students across its campuses in Pilani, Goa, Hyderabad, Mumbai and Dubai. In NIRF-2025 Rankings released by the Ministry of Education, Government of India, the institute has ranked the 7th position in the University category and secured 2nd in Pharmacy nationwide. The institute also advanced to 11th in Engineering, 18th in Research Institutions, and 16th in Overall ranking.

Minimum Eligibility Qualifications

- M.E./M.Tech./M.Pharm./MBA/M.Phil. or an equivalent Degree (a minimum of 60% aggregate)*
- M.Sc./B.E./B.Pharm. or an equivalent degree (a minimum of 60% aggregate)
- For admissions to Humanities and Social Sciences, candidates with an M.A. degree (minimum of 55% aggregate)*
- For part-time applicants, a minimum of one year experience in the related field of study is required.

In addition, departments may set specific admission criteria for shortlisting. Meeting the minimum eligibility qualifications does not guarantee admission into the PhD programme. Further details about the Admission process are available in the PhD Brochure on the Admission website.

Financial Assistance

All the full-time PhD students admitted into the PhD program will receive a fellowship up to a maximum of five

The fellowship could be from the Institute or Sponsored Projects. PhD students may also have their own fellowship if qualified through UGC/CSIR NET.

Students offered Institute fellowship will receive ₹37,000/per month. The fellowship may be enhanced to ₹40,000/or ₹42,000/- after two years based on the performance. Institute Fellows will also receive a contingency amount of ₹20,000/- per year.

Students offered admission through Sponsored Projects would receive the fellowship in accordance with the funding agency guidelines.

BITS Pilani provides International Travel Support of up to 1.5 lakh to full-time PhD students to present their work in an international conference.
